- (2) A public institution shall disclose any information that contains personal information if -
 - (a) the individual to whom it relates consents to the disclosure; or
 - (b) the information is publicly available
- (3) Where disclosure of any information referred to in this section would be in the public interest, and if the public interest in the disclosure of such information clearly outweighs the protection of the privacy of the individual to whom such information relates, the public institution to whom request for disclosure is made shall disclose such information subject to Section 14 (2) of this Act.

15.

- (1) A public institution shall deny an application for information that contains
 - trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person or business where such trade secrets or information are proprietary, privileged or confidential, or where disclosure of such trade secrets or information may cause harm to the interests of the third party provided that nothing contained in this subsection shall be construed as preventing a person or business from consenting to disclosure;
 - (b) information the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to interfere with the contractual or other negotiations of a third party; and
 - (c) proposal and bids for any contract, grants, or agreement, including information which if it were disclosed would frustrate procurement or give an advantage to any person.
- (2) A public institution shall, notwithstanding subsection (1), deny disclosure of a part of a record if that part contains the result or product of environmental testing carried out by or on behalf of a public institution.
- (3) Where the public institution discloses information, or a part thereof, that contains the results of a product or environmental testing, the institution shall at the same time as the information or part thereof is disclosed provide the applicant with a written explanation of the methods used in conducting the test.
- (4) A public institution shall disclose any information described in subsection (l) of this section if that disclosure would be in the public interest as it relates to public health, public safety or protection of the environment and, if the public interest in the disclosure clearly outweighs in importance any financial loss or gain to, or prejudice to the competitive position of or interference with contractual or other negotiation of a third party.
- 16. A public institution may deny an application for information that is subject to the following privileges -
 - (a) legal practitioner-client privilege
 - (b) health workers- client privilege;
 - (c) journalism confidently privilege;
 - (d) any other professional privileges confidently by an Act
- A public institution may deny an application for information which contains course or research materials prepared by faculty members.
- 18. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, where an application is made to a public institution for information which is exempted from disclosure by virtue of this Act, the institution shall disclose any part of the information that virtue does not contain such exempted information.
- 19. (1) A public institution may deny an application for information that contains information pertaining to -
 - (a) test questions, scoring keys and other examination data used to administer an academic examination or determine the qualifications of an application for a license or employment;
 - (b) architects' and engineers' plans for buildings not constructed in whole or in part with public funds and for buildings constructed with public funds, to the extent that disclosure would compromise security; and

RE: REOUEST FOR INFORMATION ON THE 2017 ZONAL INTERVENTION PROJECTS **EXECUTION STATUS**

Your response dated 15th January, 2019 and referenced FR/CG.500/S.2/II/374 on the above subject matter was received by us on 17th January, 2019.

We will like to further state as follow:

- 1. The exact location of the "Production of Forest Utilization Products Facilities for Patigi LGA of Kwara State" is not yet known to us. Kindly note that Patigi LGA is large. Therefore, we need you to specify where exactly in Patigi this project can be sighted, as it is difficult for our Directorate of Investigation and Public Petition to verify the project execution.
- 2. Our physical visit to **Offa-Ojoku-Afon road** shows that:
 - the road was constructed between General Hospital, Offa to Federal Polytechnic Offa gate
 - there was no road construction between Federal Polytechnic Offa gate to Igbawewe
 - the road construction started again from Igbawewe and did not even reach Ojoku
 - there was a very short construction within Ojoku town
 - there was no road construction from Ojoku to Afon

3. In addition to paragraph "2", we are aware of a fresh appropriation of another Eighty Million Naira

(N80,000,000) for the same Offa-Ojoku-Afon road in the 2018 Zonal Intervention Project, which was

captured as a project to be executed again by your Institute.

4. Apart from Offa-Ojoku-Afon road mentioned above, our physical visit to Ikotun-Ojoku-Afon road

shows that NO CONSTRUCTION has been done on this road despite the release of Forty-Nine Million,

Six Hundred and Fifty-Four Thousand, One Hundred and Twenty-Seven Naira (N49,654,127.35), which

is contrary to the 70.94% completion that you reported.

5. Our physical visit to Afon-Okesho-Ojoku-Ikotun road shows that NO CONSTRUCTION has been

done on this road despite the release of One Hundred and Fifty-Six Million, Forty-One Thousand Six

Hundred and Twelve Naira (N156,041,612.5), which is contrary to the 70.93% completion that you

reported. This road seems to have the same nomenclature and description as that mentioned in paragraph

"4" above.

TAKE NOTICE that:

i. Your decision to deny us access to the Technical Details, Bill of Engineering Measurement and

Evaluation (BEME), and certificate of Valuation (CV) of the projects under consideration is not

envisaged and supported by section 15 subsections 1a and 1b that you relied on. All the required

information is neither trade secrets nor supposed to be confidential, and their disclosure cannot cause

any harm to the interest of the third party. The disclosure of the above-mentioned information cannot

also reasonably interfere with the contractual or other negotiations of the third party.

ii. You may wish to note that Section 12 Subsection 1 Paragraph a(v) of FOI Act has further overridden

section 15 that you relied on. It states that "a public institution may deny an application for any

information which constitutes an invasion of personal privacy under section 15 of this Act, except,

where the interest of the public would be better served by having such record being made

available, this exception to disclosure shall not apply.

iii. Section 12 subsection 2 of the Freedom of Information Act 2011 that states "notwithstanding

anything contained in this section, an application for information shall not be denied where the

public interest in disclosing the information outweighs whatever injury that disclosure would

cause"

iv. Section 18 of FOI Act 2011 states that "notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, where an

application is made to a public institution for information which is exempted from disclosure by

virtue of this Act, the institution shall disclose any part of the information that virtue does not

contain such exempted information.

In conclusion, we are relying on the above-mentioned sections and other relevant sections of FOI Act 2011 to

demand for the following information:

1. The technical details of each stage of funds that you released to each contractor

2. The Bill of Engineering Measurement and Evaluation (BEME) of each project

3. The Certificate of Valuation (CV) that you raised to pay the contractor for each project

4. The exact place(s) within Patigi LGA of Kwara State where we can verify the Production of Forest

Utilization Products Facilities for Patigi LGA.
